About

This is our first club meet. A friendly meet designed to give all swimmers a chance to race together and have fun, whether it is their first meet or they are trying new longer distance events. Lots of medals to be won.

Meet Details

Short Course Meet with semi-automatic timing:

- 50m all strokes
- 100m all strokes including 100m Individual Medley
- 200m Breast, 200m Fly (11 and over), 200m Back and 200m Individual Medley
- 400m Individual Medley (11 and over), 400m Free (11 and over)
- 800m & 1500m Free (12 and over)

(Please note there will be a small number of heats in each session to accommodate limited poolside capacity)

- Age groups from 9 years to 15 years & over (with exceptions listed above).
- Age as at 4th September 2022
- All events are Heat Declared Winners
- Integrated heats will be seeded on submitted 25m pool times, 800 & 1500 Free will be mixed heats

If applicable, restrictions related to Covid-19 will be published separately.

Top 3 for all ages (Boy & Girl categories)

Entries

- Cost: £5.50 per event (except 800m and 1500m free which cost £9.50 per event)
- Minimum 2 events per swimmer in Session 2, all other sessions no minimum events
- For shorter distances entries are encouraged from new swimmers.
- Accepted entries will be available to view online; entry only via www.openmeets.co.uk
- Entry times can be modified online until the day before the meet

- Meet opens for entries on Tuesday 5th July 2022. Entries to the gala are by club invite only. This is a small meet with a limited number of races. Club invites will therefore be staggered to avoid disappointment and clubs will be notified at the point of invite which events are available (Maximum number of clubs 8). Entries will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis by available event. Once the meet is full it will be closed and notified to invited clubs on Open Meets.
- Results will be available online shortly after the gala ends.

TYS Back-to-School Blast

Rules

1. The promoter for this event is Jessica Hendon.
2. This is a Level 4 Licensed Meet (Licence No 4NE Pending) – times achieved eligible for County Championships.
3. The Competition will be held under ASA Laws & ASA Technical Rules.
4. The one start rule will apply.
5. Over the top starts will be used at the Referee's discretion. Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool.
6. All events will be heat declared winners.
7. The Referee's decision is final.
8. The pool is 25m long, 8 lanes with anti-wave lane ropes and semi-automatic timing (NB timing will begin automatically with an electronic signal from the starting unit and end manually when the timer pushes his/her button at the finish of the race, times will be visible on a scoreboard).
9. A shallow pool swim down facility will be available during the sessions (it will be withdrawn if not properly used).
10. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside. Footwear must be worn outside the pool area.
11. Ages are as at Midnight on *Sunday 4th September 2022*.
Age Groups are 9 yrs, 10 yrs, 11 yrs, 12 yrs, 13 yrs, 14 yrs and 15 yrs & Over for all events except 200m Fly and races 400m and over.
Age Groups are 11 yrs, 12 yrs, 13 yrs, 14 yrs and 15 yrs & Over for 200m Fly; 400m Free; 400 IM.
Age Groups are 12 yrs, 13 yrs, 14 yrs and 15 yrs & Over for 800 & 1500 Free.
12. Entries must be made online at www.openmeets.co.uk. Only invited clubs will be given access to make entries.
13. Submitted times are to be based on 25m pool times, or converted 50m pool times by use of the ASA Conversion. Swimmers can be entered with "No Time" but an estimated time is preferable.
14. The closing date for entries is 18th August 2022, or earlier if the meet is full.
15. Entries to the gala are by club invite only. This is a small meet with a limited number of races. Club invites will therefore be staggered to avoid disappointment and clubs will be notified at the point of invite which events are available (Maximum number of clubs 8). Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis by available event. Once the meet is full it will be closed and notified to invited clubs on Open Meets.
16. Should entries be over-subscribed, the promoter reserves the right to limit entries by rejection of the last entries to be received.
17. Withdrawals will only be refunded on medical grounds.
18. All swimmers must report to the marshalling area 6 heats prior to their heat, or when called.
19. The fees for this event are £5.50 for each individual entry for all races except 800m and 1500m. The fees for 800m and 1500m events are £9.50 for each individual entry. Minimum 2 entries per swimmer in Session 2.
20. Coaches MUST wear passes provided at all times whilst on poolside. Only swimmers with accepted entries and Coaches/Team Managers with a valid Coaches pass will be allowed on poolside.
21. Full Coaches passes are priced at £10.00 each and include start lists. At least one pass must be purchased per team. Passes must be worn on poolside and returned at the end of the meet.
22. Coaches and Team Managers are requested to ensure their swimmers respect the officials and are silent at the start of each heat.
23. Swimmers must not enter the spectator gallery whilst wet or without appropriate footwear and clothing.
24. Medals will be made as follows:
Age groups 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs and 15yrs & over – Top 3 for boys and girls
25. All awards are to be collected from the awards table during the meet.
26. Admission for spectators will be £2 per session. Depending on restrictions imposed by the venue at the time of the gala, spectator tickets might need to be limited.
27. Any point not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the Lead Referee and the Promoter.
